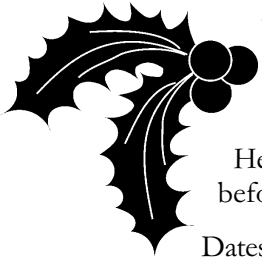




CELEBRATE THE HOLIDAY SEASON WITH PARKS
